

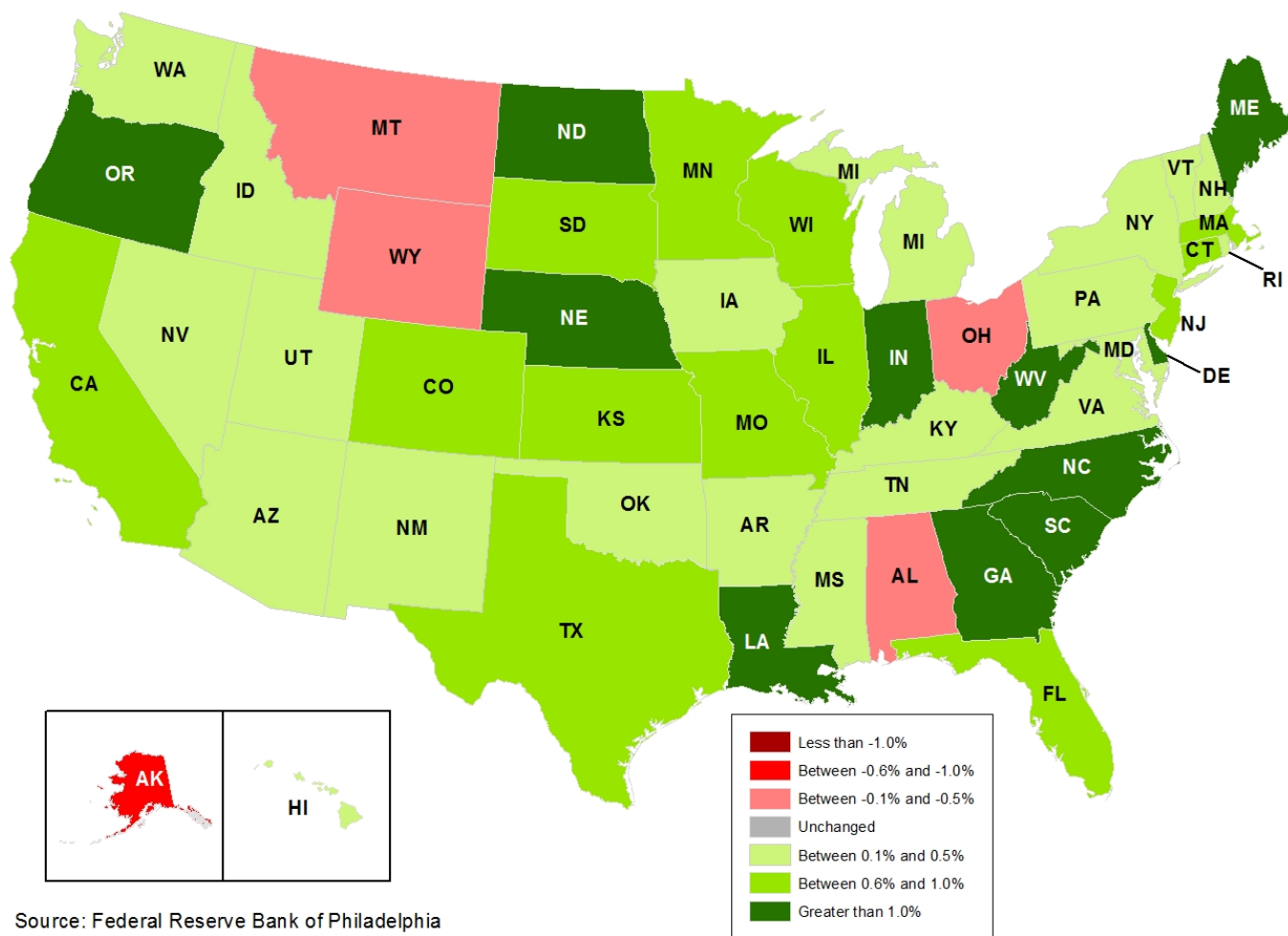
STATE COINCIDENT Indexes



OCTOBER 2013

The Federal Reserve Bank of Philadelphia has released the coincident indexes for the 50 states for October 2013. In the past month, the indexes increased in 44 states, decreased in four states, and remained stable in two, for a one-month diffusion index of 80. Over the past three months, the indexes increased in 45 states and decreased in five, for a three-month diffusion index of 80. For comparison purposes, the Philadelphia Fed has also developed a similar coincident index for the entire United States. The Philadelphia Fed's U.S. index rose 0.2 percent in October and 0.7 percent over the past three months.

THIRD DISTRICT COINCIDENT INDEXES: OCTOBER 2013

Pennsylvania

In October the coincident index for Pennsylvania rose 0.2 percent. Payroll employment and average hours worked in manufacturing increased. In addition, the unemployment rate decreased. Pennsylvania's economic activity as measured by the coincident index has risen 2.6 percent over the past 12 months.

New Jersey

The coincident index for New Jersey rose 0.1 percent in October. Payroll employment increased. Meanwhile, average hours worked in manufacturing and the unemployment rate remained stable. Overall, New Jersey's economic activity as measured by the coincident index has increased 3.7 percent over the past 12 months.

Delaware

In October the coincident index for Delaware rose 0.5 percent. Payroll employment and average hours worked in manufacturing increased. Additionally, the unemployment rate decreased. Overall, Delaware's economic activity as measured by the coincident index has increased 3.2 percent over the past 12 months.
